Yamashin Group's GHG emissions reduction targets approved by SBTi

YAMASHIN-FILTER CORP (President: Atsuhiko Yamazaki) is pleased to announce that on April 17, our greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reduction targets for FY2030 have been approved by the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi)*¹ as being based on scientific evidence to limit the global temperature rise due to global warming to less than 1.5 to 2 degrees Celsius.

*1 A joint initiative of CDP (formerly the Carbon Disclosure Project), the United Nations Global Compact (UNGC), the World Resources Institute (WRI), and the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) to assess corporate greenhouse gas reduction targets.

Target 1: Reduce absolute Scope 1 & 2 GHG emissions by 49% by FY2030 compared to FY2021 Target 2: Reduce absolute Scope 3 emissions by 25% by FY2030 compared to FY2021
